



22. Women Development Cell (2021-23)

It is responsible to advise, assist, and support activities designed to strengthen woman-students related programs. The WDC promotes the education program in the female community. Promotion may be taken up in the form of communicating with local elders, arranging publicity, presenting programs to civic groups, and authoring newspaper articles/pamphlets. Priorities for the WDC's program of work fall into following categories:

- Curriculum, review and revision from female perspective
- Female staff development and work-based learning
- Advocacy of female education
- Organising Women Oriented Programs, activities.
- Evaluation (of the program and the WDC itself)

The WDC may appoint subcommittees and determine their responsibilities, goals, and tasks. WDC's members may serve on more than one subcommittee.

A Women's Development Cell has both student and teacher representatives. It actively promotes and generates awareness on the issues concerning women's development.

Its main objective is to create awareness among the girls and the women staff, apart from maintaining congenial working environment for all the women employees and students. It arranges women oriented programs and lectures in the college. The actual number of WDC's meetings per year is determined by the requirements of the committee's Program of Work.
